Auditor of State Mary Mosiman today released a report on the State University of Iowa, Iowa City, Iowa for the year ended June 30, 2015. The State University of Iowa (University of Iowa) previously released its annual financial report for the year ended June 30, 2015.

The University of Iowa is governed by the Board of Regents. For the year ended June 30, 2015, the full-time equivalent student enrollment was 27,474 with an average cost per student of \$19,140, compared to 29,491 students and an average cost per student of \$18,912 for the year ended June 30, 2014. The University Hospitals and Clinics provided a total of 206,153 patient days at an average daily cost per patient of \$5,605 for the year ended June 30, 2015, compared to 195,807 patient days at an average daily cost per patient of \$5,420 for the year ended June 30, 2014.

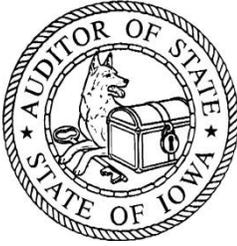

The State University of Iowa (University of Iowa or University) is a part of the State of Iowa and, as such, has been included in our audits of the State's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report and the State's Single Audit Report for the year ended June 30, 2015. We have also audited the financial statements of the University as of and for the year ended June 30, 2015 and have issued our report thereon dated December 10, 2015.

In addition to these reports, we also prepare a separate report of recommendations pertaining to the University's internal control, compliance with statutory requirements and other matters when our audits disclose findings we believe should be brought to your attention. This report is to inform you our audits of the University of Iowa did not disclose any findings we believe were necessary to report for the year ended June 30, 2015.

We have also included certain unaudited financial and other information on pages 6 and 7 to report an average cost per student for the University and an average cost per patient for the University Hospitals and Clinics for the five years ended June 30, 2015, as required by Section 11.28 of the Code of Iowa.

This report is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties.
